

ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. All entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
2. The Council of the VVGA shall have the entire management of the tournament, including handicapping with the power to alter handicaps at any time during the course of the tournament.
3. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and any modifications therefore set out in the local rules of the Euroa Golf Club.
4. The Match Committee of the VVGA shall have the power to deal with and determine any dispute or protest, which must be lodged with the VVGA Secretary within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. The Match Committee's decision is final.
5. The Council of the VVGA may, in the event of adverse weather or any other reason, either shorten any event or fix another day.
6. In the event of a tie in the Gross Event, a sudden death playoff will take place on holes 10, 17 & 18 until a result is achieved. A tie in the net event will be determined by a countback.
7. All entrants must have a current Golf Australia recognized handicap and be a financial member of a District affiliated with the VVGA and have participated in at least two (2) District events in the past 12 months.
