LOCAL RULES (to be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf and Temporary Local Rules)

1. ACCIDENTAL MOVEMENT OF A BALL ON A PUTTING GREEN

Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1. This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.

2. WRONG SCORE FOR HOLE

The Exception to Rule 6-6d is modified as follows:

If a competitor returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken due to failure to include one or more penalty strokes that. before returning their score card, they did not know they had incurred, they are not disgualified. In such circumstances, the competitor incurs the penalty prescribed by the applicable Rule, but there is no additional penalty for a breach of Rule 6-6d. This Exception does not apply when the applicable penalty is disqualification from the competition.

3. OUT OF BOUNDS

Any area beyond the Club's perimeter is Out of Bounds. When playing the 10th hole the 17th fairway is Out of Bounds. When plaving the 17th hole the 6th fairway is Out of Bounds.

4. TREES AND SHRUBS

If a tree under 2 club lengths in height interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player MUST take relief as provided in Rule 24-2B(1)

5. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS AND HOSES

All fixed sprinkler heads and hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a fixed sprinkler head on or within two club lengths of the putting green being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

6. TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ROPES, HOOPS & SIGNS

All temporary protective ropes, poles holding ropes, hoops and signs are treated as immovable obstructions & relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 24-2. If a ball strikes the Temporary Protective Ropes, the Holding Poles, the Hoops or Signs the stroke must be cancelled and replayed without penalty (See Rule 20-50.)

GARDEN BEDS 7

Garden Beds are defined by surrounding borders and relief may be taken under Rule 25-1.

WHEEL MARKS 8

9.

Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle, are ground under repair. Rule 25 applies. PATHS

All constructed pathways and their integral drainage are to be treated as immovable Obstructions. Rule 24-2B(1) applies.

10. OVERHEAD POWER WIRES AND POLES

When playing the 2nd hole if overhead power wires or poles are struck the shot must be replayed.

11. STONE WASH

All stone wash from paths is to be treated as GUR and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1. If a ball, the player's stance or area of intended swing interferes, the player may lift and drop without penalty within ONE club length not nearer the hole from the nearest point of relief.

12. EMBEDDED BALL

Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch mark may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where the ball lay but no nearer the hole

13. SUSPENSION OF PLAY - One siren blast.

14 RESUMPTION OF PLAY - Two siren blasts

15. HAZARD MARKERS 10th & 17th HOLES

When playing the 10th Hole the Yellow markers that border the left hand side of the 17th are used to indicate that it is a Water Hazard

When plaving the 17th Hole the Red markers that border the left hand side of the 17th are used to indicate that it is a Lateral Water Hazard

16. ADDITION TO LATERAL HAZARD ON 10th HOLE

Ball in hazard marked by "Red Pegs/Blue Top", must drop in zones provided!

17. NOTE ALL STAKES ARE IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION. RULE 24-2 APPLIES

PEGS: WHITE - GUR WHITE WITH BLACK TOP - 00B RED - LATERAL HAZARDS YELLOW - WATER HAZARDS
